Breach Notification

Dear

I am writing in furtherance of your conversation with Ms. Lainee Adkins of our Anchorage AK office, I am writing to let you know that, on April 7, 2013, a vehicle owned by one our employees was broken into and a laptop, along with paper files containing patient information, was stolen from the car. To the best of our knowledge and believe, the device and/or papers contained, your name, address, social security number, phone number and diagnosis codes.

While there is no evidence the person committing this crime was targeting your personal information, we know the information was in the hands of an unknown person and we want to encourage you to be aware of the overall dangers of identity theft as it relates to your financial accounts and insurance benefits.

To that end, we strongly recommend you review all personal banking accounts, credit reports, explanations of insurance benefits, etc., to ensure they are accurate. If your review identifies any suspicious activity, please immediately notify your insurer, your financial institution, the local police, and one of the three major credit bureaus to initiate a fraud alert.

For your convenience/reference, the three major credit bureaus and their contact information are as follows. Please note that, under the Fair and Accurate Transaction Act, consumers are entitled to one FREE credit report every 12 months:


