#### 2) Approval of Agenda

JB requested to discuss RCA draft regulations. GVEA has concerns about them and others may as well. Would like to consider IC comments and advise of possible GVEA comments to RCA.

DC mentioned had invited AS to join towards the end of the meeting to provide update on RCA status. He has not heard back from AS yet.

JE mentioned addition of newly introduced senate bill (SB) 69, seeking to renew 711(r) provision that exempts certain IPPs from RCA regulation. Requested to be add to update / member comments section.

#### 3) Approval of February 1 Meeting Minutes

**MOTION** to approve 2/1/2021 meeting minutes. 1JG, 2KW.

JG provided minor amendments to clarify language.

PASSED AS AMENDED with no objections [12-0-0].

#### 4) ExCom

JE provided update that ExCom plans to issue monthly progress report for February in March.

#### 5) Budget Committee (BudCom)

#### a. Charter Amendment.

JG presented revised BudCom charter and solicited IC comment. Direct comments to JG, will incorporate and bring revised charter back to IC for adoption on 2/15.

Discussion on status of overall IC/RRC draft budget and need to formalize. JG advised that the BudCom will plan to revisit this in about one month to allow some time for IC to stand up additional subcommittees. BudCom should have a better understanding by then of additional subject matter experts and associated costs that will be incurred in 2021 to complete application.

#### b. Tom Lovas Budget Amendment.

JG reviewed proposed budget amendment introduced on 2/1 and rationale.

**MOTION** that the IC approve the Energy & Resource Economics (Tom Lovas) budget amendment as presented with a not-to-exceed amount of \$20,000. 1JG, 2HK.

PASSED with no objections. [12-0-0].

#### 6) Work Plan

RSK introduced a matrix outline of the work plan. IC discussed application / ERO end-state deliverables. Sapere will continue to advance work plan and coordinate with BudCom as needed.

#### 7) Governance Topics

SD presented BySub's proposed RRC governing board member selection process and led discussion on proposed provisions. IC members provided input / guidance.

SD summarized BySub's planned schedule: draft language based on today's feedback out by Friday 2/12, additional IC comments by Tuesday 2/16, BySub rework on 2/17, with final language out by 2/19 for tentative approval by IC on 2/22.

#### 8) Updates/Member Comments

<u>RCA coordination</u>. JE: has sent several messages to BP seeking guidance on scheduling of RCA update, but no guidance received back. Fall back is to provide an update within the public comment part of the RCA meeting. SS not available at next RCA meeting on 2/10, JE coordinating with SS to provide an IC update in public comments at 2/17 meeting.

<u>Commonwealth North</u>. JE is still waiting to hear back from them on schedule. Will continue to track the matter.

Website. JE observed it needs an update on several items, on to do list.

<u>RCA draft regulations</u>. IC member discussion on the topic. Possible action to be considered at next IC meeting is to include IC comments to RCA discussing balanced governance and IC proposed governance structure.
