The Wind Turbine Technician will be part of the Operations team at AVEC. As a Wind Turbine Technician you will:

- Maintain AVEC's fleet of mainly Northern Power System Northwind 100 A and B model and EWT models wind turbines in remote rural Alaskan villages. Maintenance of future models or replacements will be expected as equipment needs or infrastructure changes.
- Perform preventative maintenance, troubleshooting, repairs and modifications to all wind turbines within the AVEC system as required.
- Ensure functionality of controls and communications between applicable wind systems and generation equipment.
- Assist with integration between wind systems and diesel power plant modules.
- Provide training to AVEC's field staff, plant operators and local hires on applicable servicing and maintenance of wind systems.
- Communicate with Cooperative staff to trouble shoot and devise solutions for service, equipment, or communication problems as able with wind systems.
- Prepare necessary reports on assigned projects and other general reports as necessary.
- Work in a safe manner and ensures the property of others or other Cooperative equipment is not damaged.

- Comply with all aspects of the OSHA (Occupational Safety and Health Standards) applicable with job requirements and training.
- Intermittent requirement to supervise/train others as directed.

To be successful, you will need:

- To be at least 18 years of age.
- High school diploma or equivalent and 10 years of directly related experience.
 - OR AA/Two-year college technical program with 5 years of directly related experience.
 - o OR bachelor's degree in related field with at least 2 years of directly related experience.
- Minimum of two years utility experience.
- Advanced Service Technician for each wind model owned/in operation within AVEC system.
 This training can be provided by AVEC if necessary.
- To travel to remote Alaska, as required.

- Be knowledgeable about safety rules and requirements for the trade.
- Possess and exhibit the ability and desire to provide prompt, courteous and reliable services to the Cooperative's internal and external customers.
- Have the ability to work with multicultural and multilingual consumers and individuals requiring patience and a calm demeanor.
- Be self-motivated with the ability to prioritize multiple conflicting priorities and projects.
- Possess excellent communication skills, ability to communicate clearly and accurately orally and in writing.
- Show concern for the safety, quality, accuracy and completeness of own work and coworkers.
- Be resourceful in using available and makeshift equipment and in facing rough terrain and adverse weather conditions.
- Maintain the ability to multitask and manage multiple projects simultaneously. Adapts to change quickly and easily.
- Demonstrate strong interpersonal skills with the ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with staff, management, cooperative members and external agencies.
